The number to call in an emergency is **000** ask an adult to show you how to dial **000** on your home phone – but remember not to call unless it's a real emergency.

*In a real emergency, such as a fire, this is what will happen if you call **000**:*

- The telephone operator will ask you if you want police, fire or ambulance.
- If you say fire, you will be connected to the fire service – so wait on the phone and a different operator will ask you what the emergency is – such as a house fire.
- You will then be asked for the location of the fire – this may include the house number, street name and town or location of the nearest road.
- Tell the operator if you think anyone is hurt or trapped.
- Wait for the operator to hang up before you do.
- Get to a safe place and wait for the firefighters to arrive.
